KID'S CORNER:

Bible Text: Acts 15:36-16:40. As Paul traveled, he started churches in other cities and taught people about Jesus. Paul's second journey took him from Antioch in Syria back to some of the cities he visited on his first journey. Paul wanted to see how the new believers were doing. One night, while Paul and Silas were in Troas, the Lord called Paul to go to Macedonia and preach the gospel to the people. Two major events happened while Paul was in Macedonia. First, a woman named Lydia became a believer when Paul and Silas opened Lydia's heart to the good news of the gospel. Then, a jailer became a believer when Paul and Silas were thrown into prison. Late at night, an earthquake rocked the prison and the jailer asked Paul and Silas how to be saved. "Believe in the Lord Jesus, and you will be saved," they said. The man believed and was baptized.

Christ Connection: Lydia, the jailer, and many others were saved because they believed in Jesus. Jesus offers us salvation as a gift. He did all the work to save us by dying on the cross. We do not need to earn salvation; we can just receive it by repenting and trusting in Jesus.

Unit Memory Verse: For I am not ashamed of this Good News about Christ. It is the power of God at work, saving everyone who believes - Jews first and also Gentiles. Romans 1:16
