KID'S CORNER:

Bible Text: John 3:22-36. Jesus and His disciples left Jerusalem & went out into the countryside where Jesus taught the people & baptized them. Nearby, John the Baptist was also baptizing people. Some of those with John ask him why Jesus was baptizing people & why they were starting to follow Him. John explained to them the purpose God had for his life. He had been chosen by God long before he was born to be a forerunner - one who prepares the way. John understood who he was & who Jesus is.

Christ Connection: John the Baptist had told people to get ready for Jesus, the promised Messiah. Now that Jesus was there, John's mission was complete. John the Baptist joyfully stepped aside as Jesus began His earthly ministry.

Unit Memory Verse: For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life. For God did not send his Son into the world to condemn the world, but to save the world through him. Jn 3:16-17
