KID'S CORNER:

Bible Text: Matt 28:16-20; Mk 16:15-16; Acts 1:3. After Jesus was raised from the dead, He met with His disciples over a 40-day period. One day He directed the eleven disciples to go to a mountain in Galilee. Jesus gave the disciples - and everyone who follows Him - a job to do. Because of Jesus' authority, He commanded His disciples to go into the world and preach the gospel, the good news about Him. The Great Commission is not just for missionaries far from home. All believers are called to share the gospel with others, teach them to obey God's commands, and baptize them in the name of the Father, Son and Holy Spirit. Jesus finishes His commission with a promise. "And remember, I am with you always, even to the end of the age."

Christ Connection: The good news about what Jesus has done to rescue us from our sins is too great to keep to ourselves. Before Jesus went back to heaven, He gave the disciples a job to do. Jesus wants His followers to teach people everywhere about Jesus so they will trust in Him as their Lord and Savior.

Unit Memory Verse: Therefore, go and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit. Teach these new disciples to obey all the commands I have given you. And be sure of this: I am with you always, even to the end of the age. Matthew 28:19-20 (NLT)
