Bible Text: Today's lesson is from Jonah 1-4. God said to Jonah, "Go to the great city of Nineveh. They have been doing very evil things; tell them to stop." Unwilling to go to Nineveh, Jonah tried to hide by taking a boat to another city. However, through a storm and some time in the belly of a fish, God got Jonah's attention. Jonah went to Nineveh. For 3 days, Jonah walked around the city. His message to the Ninevites was brief: "In 40 days Nineveh will be demolished!". The people of Nineveh repented, and God withheld His judgment.

Christ Connection: God displayed His mercy and grace by forgiving the people of Nineveh when they repented of their sin. God showed His love to the rest of the world by sending His Son, Jesus, to die on the cross. God saves those who trust in Jesus and repent of their sin, and He sends them out, like Jonah, with the good news of salvation.
