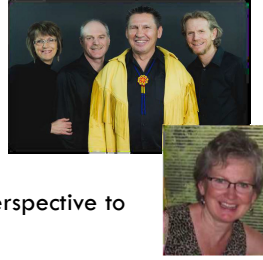


## COMMUNITY EVENTS

### KID'S CORNER:

**Bible Text:** Matthew 4:1-11; Mark 1:12-13; Luke 4:1-13. After Jesus was baptized, the Holy Spirit led Him into the wilderness where He fasted for 40 days. Jesus was hungry and the Devil tempted him by saying "If You are the Son of God, tell these stones to become bread." When Jesus refused, the Devil continued to tempt Jesus but Jesus always refused. Jesus chose to trust God to meet His needs.

We will also be hearing from Mission Partners Alastair and Shelley Wyatt.

**Christ Connection:** Jesus was tempted, but He never sinned. Jesus is perfect and righteous. A perfect sacrifice was required to take away sin. Jesus was that perfect sacrifice. He died on the cross to free us from sin and to give us the power to say no to temptation.

**Unit Memory Verse:** The Word became flesh and made his dwelling among us. We have seen his glory, the glory of the one and only Son, who came from the Father, full of grace and truth. John 1:14
