## KID'S CORNER:

**Bible Text:** Today's children's lesson is from Isaiah 6. One day Isaiah was worshipping God in the temple when he had a vision of God. The magnitude of God's holiness made Isaiah realize the magnitude of his own sin. God took away Isaiah's guilt. Isaiah then heard God's voice say "Whom shall I send, and who will go for us?" Isaiah answered "Here am I! Send me." God sent Isaiah to preach to the people of Judah.

**Christ Connection:** Isaiah saw God in a vision and he knew he didn't deserve to be with God because God is holy. God forgave Isaiah's sin. One day God would send His Son, Jesus, to pay for Isaiah's sin. God forgives anyone who trusts in Jesus. When we trust in Jesus, we answer like Isaiah: "Here I am. Send me."

**Unit Memory Verse:** We all, like sheep, have gone astray, each of us has turned to our own way; and the LORD has laid on him the iniquity of us all. Isaiah 53:6
