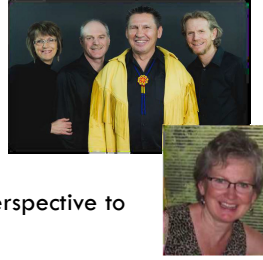


COMMUNITY EVENTS

KID'S CORNER:

Bible Text: Matt. 4:18-22; 9:9-13; Mk 1:16-20; 2:13-14; 3:13-19; Lk 5:27-32; 6:12-16. When Jesus chose disciples, His strategy was unusual. Instead of waiting for students, He sought them out. The Twelve - Peter, James (son of Zebedee), John, Andrew, Philip, Bartholomew, Matthew, Thomas, James (son of Alphaeus), Thaddaeus, Simon & Judas - travelled with Jesus during His ministry. He taught them how to think & live in light of God's coming kingdom & sent them to teach others about Him.

Christ Connection: Jesus taught His disciples to teach others about Him. The good news about Jesus is too great to not share with the entire world! Jesus came to save people from their sin.

Unit Memory Verse: The Word became flesh and made his dwelling among us. We have seen his glory, the glory of the one and only Son, who came from the Father, full of grace and truth. John 1:14
