



KID'S CORNER:

Bible Text: Matthew 3:13-17; Mark 1:1-11: Luke 3:21-22: John 1:19-34. When God's word came to John the Baptist he began preaching near the Jordan River. He called the people to repent for their sins, and baptized then in the river. Jesus came from Galilee to be baptized by John. John was confused because he baptized people who confessed their sins and Jesus had never sinned. Jesus said, "Allow me to be baptized. God says this is right." So he baptized Jesus.

Christ Connection: Jesus never sinned but He was baptized like sinners are baptized. Baptism reminds us of Jesus death and resurrection. It reminds us that when we trust in Jesus, we turn from sin and start a new life - a life lived for Jesus.

Unit Memory Verse: The Word became flesh and made his dwelling among us. We have seen his glory, the glory of the one and only Son, who came from the Father, full of arace and truth, John 1:14
