Bible Text:

Today's lesson is from Joel 1-3. The prophet Joel spoke to the Southern Kingdom of Judah at a time when the nation faced a crisis. The land had been invaded by locusts which devastated the plants. In addition to the locusts, there was a severe drought. Joel announced that these were not mere natural disasters - the Lord was judging the people for their sin. Joel implored them, "Return to the Lord your God. For He is gracious and compassionate, slow to anger, rich in faithful love, and He relents from sending disaster."

Christ Connection: God used locusts & drought to get Judah's attention. They had turned from God, & the prophet Joel called them to repent. Like Joel, Jesus calls sinners to repent. Jesus died & was resurrected so repentant people could experience forgiveness.

KID'S CORNER:

Unit Memory Verse: I knew that you are a gracious and compassionate God, slow to anger and abounding in love, a God who relents from sending calamity. Jonah 4:2
