




Tithes and Offerings can be placed in the offering envelopes and deposited in the boxes at the gym doors or outside the Library.

### KID'S CORNER:

**Bible Text:** Mk 16:12-13; Lk 24:13-35. On the day of Jesus' resurrection, two disciples were walking to Emmaus, arguing about recent events. Jesus joined them, but God prevented them from recognizing Him. Jesus asked them what they were discussing and they were surprised He hadn't heard what had happened. The two disciples explained how they hoped Jesus was the Redeemer of Israel and were crushed because Jesus had died. Jesus explained to them why the Messiah had to die, starting with Moses and the Prophets. When they reached Emmaus, the disciples urged Him to stay and eat. As soon as Jesus blessed the bread and broke it, "their eyes were opened" and they knew they'd seen Jesus. (Lk 24:31)

Christ Connection: The Bible is about Jesus. When Adam and Eve sinned, God began working out His plan to send Jesus to rescue people from sin. (Genesis 3:15) All of the Old Testament points forward to Jesus' life, death, and resurrection—the time when Jesus would bring God's promised salvation for sinners.

Unit Memory Verse: Therefore, go and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit. Teach these new disciples to obey all the commands I have given you. And be sure of this: I am with you always, even to the end of the age. Matthew 28:19-20 (NLT)
