## KID'S CORNER:

**Bible Text:** Luke 24:36-49; John 20:19-29; Acts 1:3. As Jesus' disciples gathered together in a house Jesus came and stood among them. At first the disciples were afraid and could not believe what they were seeing. Jesus showed them His hands and His side to prove that He was not a ghost. The disciples rejoiced and Jesus talked to them and explained the Bible to them. "The Bible is about Me," Jesus said. Then Jesus told them that they had a job to do. Jesus had died and was raised from the dead so that people could be forgiven for their sins. The disciples needed to tell other people to repent from their sin and be forgiven.

**Christ Connection:** God made Jesus alive again! For 40 days, Jesus presented Himself to at least 500 people and proved that He is alive (1 Corinthians 15:3-8). Jesus is still alive today.



**Unit Memory Verse:** Therefore, go and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit. Teach these new disciples to obey all the commands I have given you. And be sure of this: I am with you always, even to the end of the age. Matthew 28:19-20 (NLT)
