KID'S CORNER:

Bible Text: Matt 21:12-17; Mk 11:15-19; Lk 19:45-48. Before the Passover feast, Jesus made His triumphal entry into Jerusalem. Entering the Court of the Gentiles, He was furious to see people buying and selling in the temple; treating it like a market, not like a house of prayer for all nations, as God had intended. After Jesus threw out the merchants and money changers, the chief priest and the scribes wanted to destroy Him.

Christ Connection: Jesus was angry at the misuse of the temple, the place to go and meet with God. Christians don't go to a temple to meet with God or to offer sacrifices for sin. Jesus died on the cross as the final payment for sin, and we come together to worship Him.

Unit Memory Verse: Gathering the twelve disciples around him, Jesus told them, "As you know, we are going to Jerusalem. And when we get there, all the predictions of the ancient prophets concerning the Son of Man will come true. Luke 18:31 (NLT)
