## KID'S CORNER:

**Bible Text:** Today's children's lesson is from 2 Kings 17:1-23. God had been patient with the Israelites but after many years had passed God knew His people would not love Him with all their hearts. God allowed their enemies to send them into exile. The king of Assyria attacked Israel and after laying siege to Samaria, Assyria forced the people to leave the city. The Northern Kingdom of Israel was destroyed.

**Christ Connection:** When the Israelites disobeyed God, God judged their sin and punished them by removing them from His presence. Jesus took the punishment for our sin upon Himself. He unites and restores those who trust in Him. Jesus brings us into God's presence and keeps us there.

**Unit Memory Verse:** I seek you with all my heart; do not let me stray from your commands. I have hidden your word in my heart that I might not sin against you. Psalm 119: 10-11
