KID'S CORNER:

Bible Text: Luke 2:1-20. Joseph and Mary left Nazareth and travelled to Bethlehem. While there it came time for Mary to have her baby but the only place available was a stable. Jesus was born in a stable and God sent Angels to tell the shepherds that the Savior was born. The shepherds travelled to Bethlehem where they found Joseph, Mary and a baby laying in a feeding trough. The shepherds went and told others about the baby Jesus.

Christ Connection: The birth of Jesus was good news! Jesus was not an ordinary baby. He was God's Son, sent to earth from heaven. Jesus came into the world to save people from their sins and to be their King.

Unit Memory Verse: The Word became flesh and made his dwelling among us. We have seen his glory, the glory of the one and only Son, who came from the Father, full of grace and truth. John 1:14
