YOUNG ADULTS:

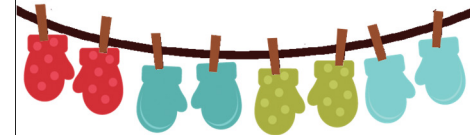

Bible Text: Today's lesson is from Amos 1-9. Amos was a farmer in Judah. One day, God called Amos saying; "Go, prophesy to My people Israel". Amos was to warn the people of God's coming punishment because of their sin. When Amos announced that God was going to judge Judah and Israel it was news they did not want to hear! The message to Israel ended with a reminder: God is merciful and loving, and His plan would not end with Israel's punishment.

Christ Connection: God is holy and just, but He is also loving and gracious. God wanted His people to turn back to Him, but they refused. Israel faced the punishment for their sin. God sent Jesus to take the punishment for our sin. God accepts anyone who trusts in Jesus as Lord and Savior.

Unit Memory Verse: I knew that you are a gracious and compassionate God, slow to anger and abounding in love, a God who relents from sending calamity. Jonah 4:2
