KID'S CORNER:

Bible Text: Luke 2:21-40. Joseph and Mary took Jesus to the temple in Jerusalem to be dedicated. Mary and Joseph presented Jesus to the Lord and offered two birds as a sacrifice. While at the temple, God revealed to a man named Simeon and a woman named Anna that Jesus was the One - the promised Messiah they had been waiting for.

Christ Connection: Throughout the Old Testament, God promised the arrival of a king who would redeem God's people. When Jesus arrived, Simeon and Anna knew He was the promised Messiah. Today, we have faith that Jesus is God's Son. We can trust Jesus for our salvation, and like Simeon and Anna, we should share the good news.

Unit Memory Verse: The Word became flesh and made his dwelling among us. We have seen his glory, the glory of the one and only Son, who came from the Father, full of grace and truth. John 1:14
