### KID'S CORNER:

**Bible Text:** Luke 2:41-52. When Jesus was 12 years old, Jesus, Mary, and Joseph went to Jerusalem for the Passover Festival. When it was time to go home, Mary and Joseph began traveling to Nazareth with a large group of people and did not notice that Jesus was not with them. When Mary and Joseph travelled back to Jerusalem to find Jesus they finally found Him in the temple complex, sitting among the teachers. Jesus was listening to the teachers and asking them questions.

**Christ Connection:** Jesus went to the temple to worship. He is God's Son, and He came to do God's work. Jesus taught people, suffered, died on the cross for our sins, and rose from the dead so that we too can worship God.

**Unit Memory Verse:** The Word became flesh and made his dwelling among us. We have seen his glory, the glory of the one and only Son, who came from the Father, full of grace and truth. John 1:14
