## KID'S CORNER:

**Bible Text:** Today's children's lesson is from 2 Kings 5. Naaman, the commander of the Syrian army, was sick with leprosy. A slave girl wanted to help Naaman and told him the prophet Elisha could help him. When Naaman came to Elisha's house Elisha ordered him to wash 7 times in the Jordan River. Although Naaman was angry his servants encouraged him to go in the river and when he did he was healed. After that Naaman believed that the God of Israel is the one true God.

**Christ Connection:** Naaman was sick with a skin problem. His disease went away when he washed in the river. All people are sick with a sin problem. We all need a Healer. When we trust Jesus as Lord and Savior, God forgives our sin and heals us.

**Unit Memory Verse:** I seek you with all my heart; do not let me stray from your commands. I have hidden your word in my heart that I might not sin against you. Psalm 119: 10-11
