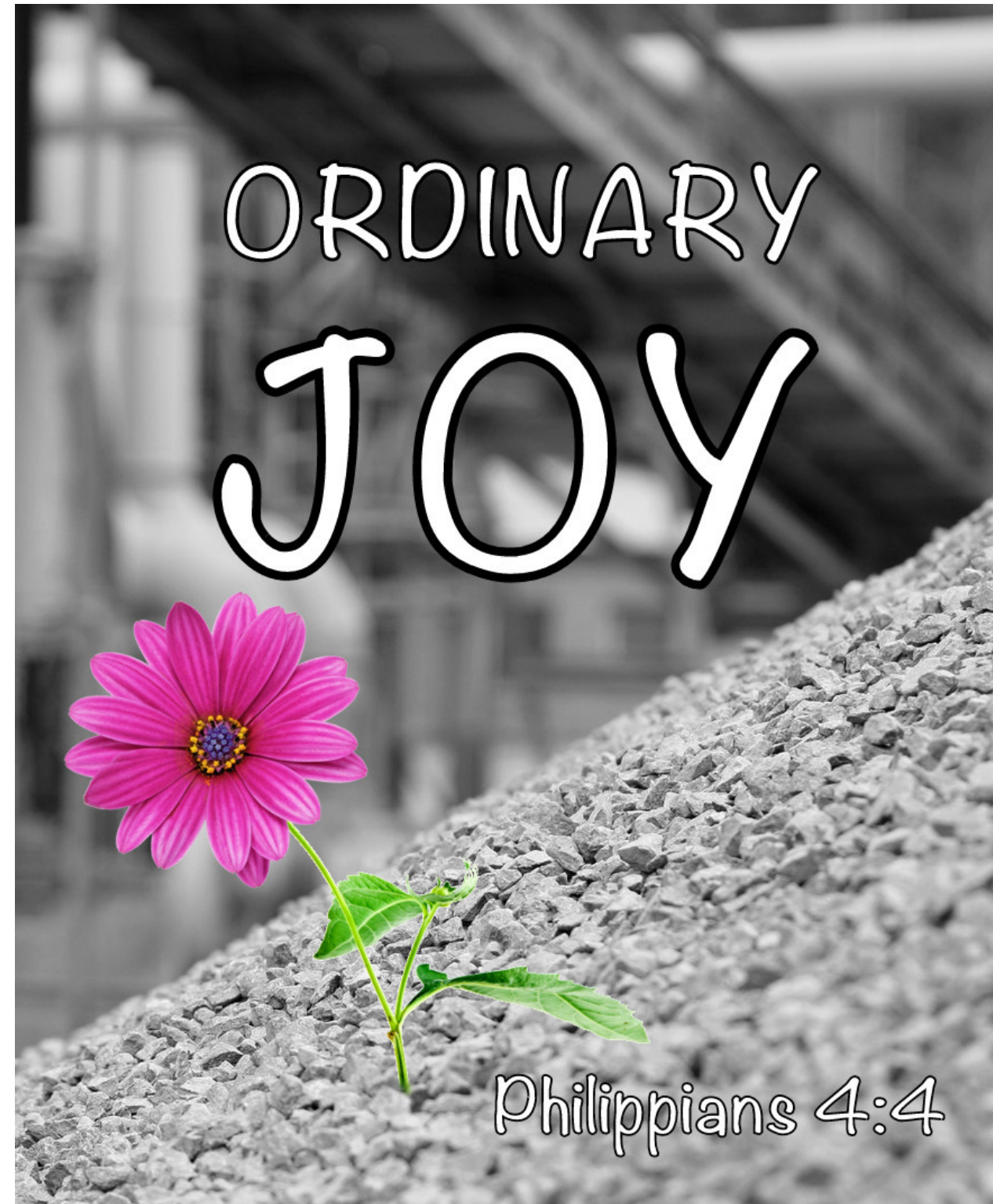

## KID'S CORNER:

**Bible Text:** Matthew 5-7. One day Jesus went up on a mountain, sat down and began to teach His disciples about the kingdom of God. Jesus taught the people how to live, how to treat each other, and how to love God. This sermon became known as the Sermon on the Mount.

**Christ Connection:** The Scribes and Pharisees looked righteous on the outside, but Jesus taught His disciples about a righteousness that comes from the inside. People who know and love Jesus have changed hearts that want to honour Jesus.



**Unit Memory Verse:** "But seek first his kingdom and his righteousness, and all these things will be given to you as well." Matthew 6:33
