KID'S CORNER:

Bible Text: Today's lesson is from Ezekiel 37. In another vision, God shows Ezekiel to a valley filled with dry bones, which represented Israel. Ezekiel prophesied that God would put tendons, flesh and skin on the bones. He would put breath in them so they would come to life. Ezekiel encouraged the exiles. Apart from God they were dead but God was offering them life. He would restore their future.

Christ Connection: The dry bones that God showed Ezekiel remind us what we are like when we sin. God had a plan to deal with our sin. Because Jesus came to earth, died, and was raised to life, He has the power to give us eternal life.

Unit Memory Verse: My dwelling place will be with them; I will be their God, and they will be my people. Ezekiel 37:27
