KID'S CORNER:

Bible Text: Rev. 19 - 22. While he was a prisoner on the island of Patmos, the apostle John had an amazing vision of heaven. John saw things that will happen when Jesus comes back to earth. Jesus will come victoriously, riding on a white horse. His name will be on His robe and His thigh: KING OF KINGS AND LORD OF LORDS. John described the beauty of the New City—the New Jerusalem. The streets will be pure gold, like clear glass. The foundations of the city wall will be adorned with precious stones. The city will not need the sun or the moon because God's glory will illuminate it. There will be no darkness, and nothing evil will ever come into the city.

Christ Connection: Jesus promised to come back to earth soon. When Christ returns, those who trust in Jesus will be with Him and enjoy Him forever. God will undo every bad thing caused by sin—no more death, no more pain, no more tears. Jesus is making all things new.

Toddler/Nursery (0-36 months)
