## KID'S CORNER:

**Bible Text:** In Luke 15, Jesus told three parables to the crowd of tax collectors, sinners, Pharisees, and scribes. In one, a man loses a sheep. He leaves his flock to find the missing sheep, and he rejoices when it is found. In the second, a woman loses a silver coin. The woman carefully searches her home. After finding the coin she calls her neighbors and friends to celebrate with her. Heaven rejoices when even one sinner repents. Finally, Jesus told a parable about two sons. The younger son asked for his inheritance. He wasted his money on immoral living and decided to return to his father. Rather than rejecting his wayward son, the father embraced him. The older son, who had always been obedient to his father, reacted with anger.

**Christ Connection:** A shepherd was seeking his sheep, a woman was seeking her coin, and a father was seeking his prodigal son. Jesus told these parables to teach about Himself. As Savior, Jesus seeks sinners. He paid the ultimate price—His own life—to save people from sin.

**Unit Memory Verse:** "But seek first his kingdom and his righteousness, and all these things will be given to you as well." Matthew 6:33

#### Toddler/Nursery (0-36 months)
