KID'S CORNER:

Bible Text: Today's lesson is from Daniel 3. King Nebuchadnezzar built a gold statue and issued a new law: "When you hear music, you are to fall down and worship the statue." Shadrach, Meshach and Abednego refusing to bow down and worship the statue were thrown into a fiery furnace, where something miraculous happened. Nebuchadnezzar saw four men walking around in the fire! The Lord not only rescued the three men, He was with them.

Christ Connection: Only God could rescue Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego from the fire. Jesus is the only One who can save us from our sin. Jesus' sacrifice on the cross provided the way for us to be rescued and have eternal life.



Unit Memory Verse: He rescues and he saves; he performs signs and wonders in the heavens and on the earth. He has rescued Daniel from the power of the lions. Daniel 6:27
