KID'S CORNER:

Bible Text: Today's lesson is from Ezekiel 10. Ezekiel was a prophet to Judah during their exile in Babylon. God's messages to Ezekiel came as visions, full of symbols and signs. In the vision of Ezekiel 10 God told the man in linen to scatter coals over Jerusalem, a symbol of both punishment and purification. God's judgment was also demonstrated by His departure from the temple.

Christ Connection: God left the temple because He was unhappy with His people's sin. Sin separates us from God. Jesus came to earth to fix our relationship with God by taking the punishment of our sin. Because of Jesus, we can turn from our sin, trust in Him, and enjoy God's presence forever.

Unit Memory Verse: My dwelling place will be with them; I will be their God, and they will be my people. Ezekiel 37:27
