KID'S CORNER:

Bible Text: Acts 6:1-7. After Jesus' resurrection and return to heaven, more and more people believed in Him. But some of the believers complained. The Greek-speaking Jews thought the widows were being overlooked when the daily food was given out. In the Old Testament, God told His people to take care of widows. The twelve apostles gathered all the believers together and said "It isn't right for us to stop preaching about God to take care of all these daily things. So, brothers, choose seven men to take care of this." Everyone agreed that this was a good idea. So they chose seven men who were wise and full of the Holy Spirit: Stephen, Philip, Prochorus, Nicanor, Timon, Parmenas, and Nicolaus.

Christ Connection: The apostles believed that everyone in the church had an important job to do to serve God's people and help spread the gospel. Jesus wants us to serve others so that the message of His death and resurrection can be heard and believed all over the world.

Unit Memory Verse: They joined with the other believers and devoted themselves to the apostles' teaching and fellowship, sharing in the Lord's Supper and in prayer ... All the while praising God and enjoying the goodwill of all the people. And each day the Lord added to their group those who were being saved. Acts 2: 42, 47
