## KID'S CORNER:

**Bible Text:** Today's children's lesson is from 2 Kings 18-20. King Hezekiah led the people of Judah to worship God as they had been told to. But when the king of Assyria and his army came to Judah, Hezekiah didn't trust God to protect His people. He tried to stop the army by giving the king money but it wasn't enough. When he prayed and asked God to save them from Assyria, Isaiah came to Hezekiah with a message: God had heard his prayers and was going to protect them.

**Christ Connection:** Hezekiah was a faithful king who led the people to honour God like, but even good kings are sinners. Jesus is our faithful King who never sinned. One day He will return to restore all things. Jesus is our King forever.

**Unit Memory Verse:** We all, like sheep, have gone astray, each of us has turned to our own way; and the LORD has laid on him the iniquity of us all. Isaiah 53:6
