KID'S CORNER:

Bible Text: This is our 2nd lesson leading up to Easter. John 13-17. During the Passover meal Jesus washed His disciples' feet - even Judas'. After Judas left to betray Jesus, Jesus said: "Now the Son of Man is glorified, and God is glorified in Him" (Jn 13:31). He told them He would prepare a place for them (Jn 14:1-4), promised the Holy Spirit would come (Jn 14:26; 15:26; 16:7-14), warned about the trials they would face as His followers (Jn 16:1-4,33), and encouraged them through prayer (Jn 17:9-19). He also prayed for all who would believe the gospel through their testimony (Jn 17:20-26). Then Jesus lead them to the garden where He was betrayed and arrested.

Christ Connection: Jesus washed the disciples' feet, something a lowly servant would do. He showed love even to His enemies when He washed Judas' feet. As sinners, we are all enemies of God. But God proved His love for us in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us. (Rom 5:8)

Unit Memory Verse: For we know that since Christ was raised from the dead, he cannot die again; death no longer has mastery over him. Romans 6:9
