KID'S CORNER:

Bible Text: This Sunday is our 3rd lesson leading up to Easter and comes from Matt. 21:1-17; Mk. 11:1-11; Luke 19:28-44; John 12:12-19. It was time to celebrate Passover and many of God's people traveled to Jerusalem for the occasion. Jesus and His disciples traveled to Jerusalem as well. Jesus entered the city by riding on a donkey and the people laid branches and their robes on the ground in front of Him. The people believed He was the promised Messiah, but they expected Him to be a political leader and set up an earthly throne. Jesus sent a different message when He entered Jerusalem

Christ Connection: During Jesus' triumphal entry, the people welcomed Him as King. Jesus was the Messiah spoken about by the prophet Zechariah: "Look, your King is coming to you; He is righteous and victorious, humble and riding on a donkey, on a colt, the foal of a donkey" (Zechariah 9:9).

Unit Memory Verse: For we know that since Christ was raised from the dead, he cannot die again; death no longer has mastery over him. Romans 6:9
