**Bible Text:** Today's lesson is from Jeremiah 1. Judah was deep in idol worship and other sins so God called Jeremiah to warn them of God's judgment. God gave Jeremiah two visions. 1) A branch of an almond tree - was a sign that God would keep His promise to send judgment and He would do it soon. 2) A boiling pot - meant that God's judgment was coming from the north. God would bring the Babylonians from the north as judgment on His people.

**Christ Connection:** Jeremiah challenged the way people lived in Judah and called them to turn away from their idol worship and other sins. Christ did more than challenge how people lived; He called people to turn from their sins, and He provided the way for people to have a relationship with God.
