## KID'S CORNER:

**Bible Text:** Acts 21:17-28:31. While in Jerusalem some Jews accused Paul of teaching against God and they tried to kill him. Fortunately, a Roman army commander stopped them and arrested Paul. While in prison, the Lord told Paul that he would one day teach about Him in Rome and after two years in prison he was sent to Rome to be heard by Caesar. While on the way to Rome Paul and the others were shipwrecked off the island of Malta. After many months, Paul finally got on another ship and sailed to Rome. Paul was still a prisoner but was allowed to stay in a house by himself with a guard. People came to Paul's house and listened to him speak. He taught people about the kingdom of God and about the Lord Jesus Christ.

**Christ Connection:** Paul's work to spread the good news of Jesus continued in Rome. No punishment or suffering kept Paul from telling others about Jesus. The Holy Spirit gives believers power to share the gospel all over the world so people will know and love Jesus.

### Unit Memory Verse:

For I am not ashamed of this Good News about Christ. It is the power of God at work, saving everyone who believes - Jews first and also Gentiles. Romans 1:16
