KID'S CORNER:

Bible Text: Matthew 8:1-4; Mark 1:40-45; Luke 5:12-16. Jesus came to a town where a man with leprosy lived. A person with leprosy was considered 'unclean' and they had to live alone, away from everyone else. When the man with leprosy saw Jesus he fell facedown and begged Jesus to heal him. Jesus reached out His hand and touched the man and the man's disease was immediately gone. Jesus ordered the man to keep quiet but the man did not listen and news about Jesus spread throughout the area. Jesus could no longer walk into a town without being noticed.

Christ Connection: Not only did Jesus have the power to make a leper clean, He was willing to make him clean. Like the disease of leprosy, sin deeply affects all people and makes them spiritually dead. Jesus willingly died on the cross and rose from the dead to save us from our sin and give us new life.

Unit Memory Verse: Jesus performed many other signs in the presence of his disciples, which are not recorded in this book. But these are written that you may believe that Jesus is the Messiah, the Son of God, and that by believing you may have life in his name. John 20:30-31
