Bible Text: Today's lesson is from the book of Nahum. Nahum was a prophet to Nineveh, the capital of Assyria. The people of Nineveh were strong and wicked, and he was sent to tell them God's judgment was coming. "The Lord will never leave the guilty unpunished" (Nah 1:3). Along with the message of judgment, Nahum brought a message of comfort for those who trusted in God. When God's judgment came upon Nineveh, His people would be safe (Nah 1:7).

Christ Connection: Nahum brought a message of comfort, reminding God's people that God loves them and will protect them from their enemies. Jesus' message of comfort assures us of salvation and peace. All of the enemies of God and the enemies of God's children were defeated at the cross. In the end, all evil will be punished.

Unit Memory Verse: The LORD your God is with you, the Mighty Warrior who saves. He will take great delight in you; in his love he will no longer rebuke you, but will rejoice over you with singing. Zephaniah 3:17.
