## KID'S CORNER:

**Bible Text:** Matthew 8:14-17; Mark 1:29-31; Luke 4:38-39. Jesus was in Capernaum when He went to the house of Simon Peter and Andrew. Peter's mother-in-law also lived in the house, but she was ill. Jesus' disciples told Jesus about the woman's condition, and Jesus went to her side. Touching the woman's hand, Jesus healed her. People in the area heard about the healing of Peter's mother-in-law so they came to Jesus afflicted by illness or unclean spirits, and Jesus healed them. Jesus did these things so that the words of Isaiah would come true. "He Himself took our weaknesses and carried our diseases" (Isa. 53:5).

**Christ Connection:** The prophet Isaiah wrote that the promised Messiah would bear our sickness and carry our pain. Jesus fulfilled this prophecy as He healed people. Sickness exists because the world is broken by sin. One day, when Jesus returns, there will be no more sickness because Jesus dealt with sin on the cross.

**Unit Memory Verse:** Jesus performed many other signs in the presence of his disciples, which are not recorded in this book. But these are written that you may believe that Jesus is the Messiah, the Son of God, and that by believing you may have life in his name. John 20:30-31

**Toddler/Nursery (0-36 months)**
